BendPak Technical Service Bulletin RS-Series Spray-Wash Cabinets Electrical Specification Change

TSB 102-112022

The purpose of this Technical Service Bulletin is to detail changes to the **Electrical Specifications** and **Power Source** instructions, due to the addition of a **Dual Heating Element**. The additional Heating Element increases the effectiveness and speed of the cleaning process. This TSB applies to the BendPak Ranger RS Series Spray-Wash Cabinets Installation and Operation Manual, P/N 5900245 Revision C1, released July 2021.

1. The **Motor Specifications** (pg. 6) for the Single and Three-Phase Spray-Wash Cabinets is to be removed and replaced with the data as detailed in the table below.

2. The **Power Source Section** (pg.10) is to be removed and replaced with the text detailed below.

Power Source

The Spray-Wash Cabinet does not include a connector on the end of the Power Cord; it is your responsibility to supply the connector and have an Electrician attach it to the Power Cord.

Refer to the **Wiring Diagrams** for detailed wiring information.



All electrical work, such as attaching the connector to the Power Cord, must be completed by a licensed, certified Electrician in accordance with local, state and national Electrical Codes.

Your Electrician needs to:

- Attach a connector to the end of the Power Cord, so that it may be connected to the power source.
- Install a GFCI Circuit Breaker / Disconnect Box for the Spray Wash unit.
- **RS500-D-601** and **RS750-D-601** Single-Phase Spray Washers require a 2-Pole GFCI Circuit Breaker rated for 220VAC, 50A, 60 Hz. and a NEMA L6-50 or equal Plug and Receptacle.
- **RS500-D-503** and **RS750-D-503** Three-Phase Spray Washers require a 3-Pole GFCI Circuit Breaker rated for 380-415 VAC, 32A, 50Hz.
- Refer to the **Wiring Diagrams** in this manual for detailed information.
- Ensure that the installation is in accordance with all local, state and national electrical codes.
